

How does HISP work?

- · Students are in two to three courses together in HISP. Other courses are taken outside the program.
- · The curriculum is integrated, with literature and social science courses overlapping in subject matter and reinforcing student learning.
- · Students move through the four years as a cohort, while each year they will meet new peers in their cohort, as students in their courses will shift each year. By the senior year, HISP students know most everyone in the graduating class.
